

Madrona PFAS Pollution Timeline

October 2022-July 2025

October 2022

- Olympic View collects samples from stormwater structures at Madrona School to test for PFAS.

November 2022

- Anatek Labs report confirms PFAS contamination:
 - **PFOA: 32.2 ppt**
 - **PFOS: 18.9 ppt**
 - Both exceed EPA MCLs (4 ppt).

January 2023

- Olympic View notifies Edmonds School District.
 - Shares lab results, a site sketch, and comparison spreadsheet.
 - Notes that PFAS is **not included** in current UIC sampling.
 - Warns of aquifer degradation risk and forwards data to Ecology.

October 2023

- ESD conducts voluntary PFAS sampling.
- PFAS detected above EPA/State limits.

November 2024

- ESD submits PFAS Investigation Work Plan to Ecology.

December 2024

- Edmonds School District follow-up stormwater sampling confirms high PFAS levels.

January 2025

- Bioretention soil tests results show PFAS leachability:
 - Stockpile soils show **PFOA: 100 ng/L**.

March 2025

- Ecology issues **corrective action request letter** to ESD:
 - Recommends soil/media removal and replacement.
 - Orders additional sampling and "first flush" monitoring in the fall of 2025.

May 2025

- Ecology issues additional **corrective action request letter** to ESD:
 - Recommends additional soil/media removal and replacement.
- Olympic View sends the Edmonds School District a notice of intent letter that they intend to file a citizen suit for PFAS pollution and violation of environmental laws at Madrona School.

July 2025

- The Edmonds School District and Olympic View meet to discuss and exchange information about PFAS at the Madrona School.
- The Edmonds School District provides additional data for review to Olympic View.
- Citizen suit against the Edmonds School District in Federal court for violation of environmental laws.
